

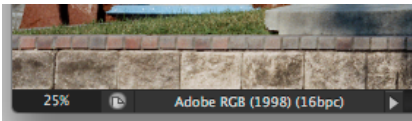
# Color Photo Printing with Photoshop CS6 & OSX (10.8 Mountain Lion)

Before starting, be sure to do the following:

- Resize/Resample your image so that it fits on the paper and the resolution is 240ppi.
- Be sure the RGB working space in Photoshop is set to Adobe RGB (1998).
- Check that the monitor has been recently and correctly profiled.

Now for printing:

1. Check that the embedded document profile is Adobe RGB (1998) by clicking the arrow and choosing the option for **“Document Profile”** in the bottom left corner of your photoshop document window.



2. Go to **File > Print**. Then check these options in the Photoshop Print Window and later in the Epson Print Window.

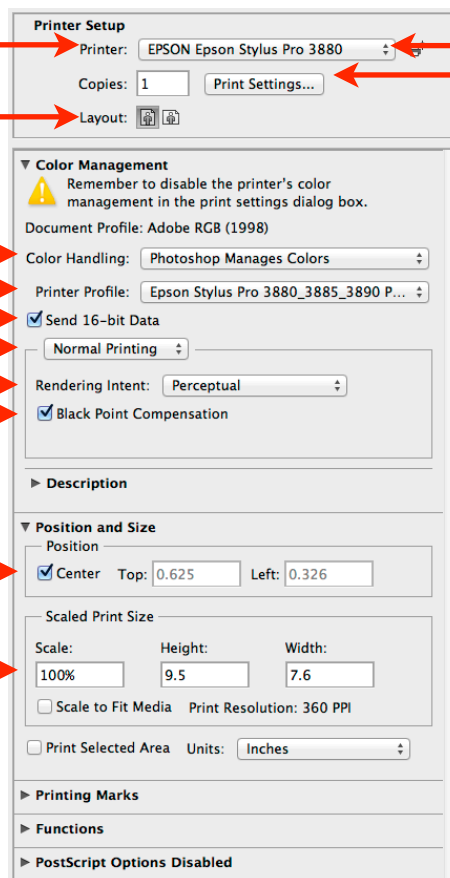
- Choose the correct printer

- Layout (vertical vs. horizontal)

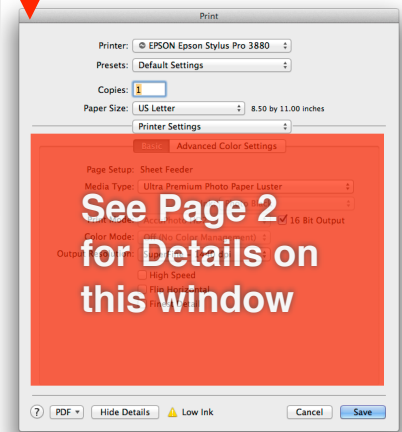
- Photoshop for Color Printing
- Epson 3800/Luster typically
- **ON** for 16-bit files
- Normal Printing typically
- **Perceptual** or **Relative Color..**
- **Black Point Compensation ON**

- **Center ON**

- **Scaling 100%**  
if you've already resized in Photoshop (recommended)



- Printer Utility, use for head cleaning
- **Print Settings:**  
Launches the “Print” Window with a few printer specific options



3. Now select **Printer Settings** to set options for the Epson printer and print quality.

- Choose the correct printer →
- Paper size/media feeder →
- Choose **Printer Settings** →
- Choose **Basic** →
- Changed via “Paper Size” →
- Choose the correct paper →
- Changed via “Media Type” →
- Auto Color Printing →
- Photoshop Manages Color →
- **1440** for final prints →
- **OFF** for best quality →
- **ON** for 16 bit files →
- Return to the Photoshop Print Window →

4. Check the Preview area, load photo paper in the printer and click **Print**.

- Confirm Paper Size →
- Visually confirm the image area vs. margins as well as centering →
- Click **Print**, Enjoy!
