

# Web Design: Week 6 | Physical Therapy Alpha Website Style Guide

1. Setup your site according to the Week5 worksheet.
2. Create a div and assign it the class "container".
3. Nest other divs within the container div, assigning unique id's to each one. These are the names we use in class for the PTAlpha website. Your names and css will vary, but you can refer to the example code below. Also use Blueprint styles as needed.

4. `body` {  
    background-image: url(images/bgblue.jpg);  
    background-repeat: repeat-y;  
    background-position:center;  
    background-attachment:fixed;  
    background-color: #eee;}
5. `.container` {  
    background-image:url(images/bggreen.jpg);  
    background-repeat: no-repeat;  
    background-position:0px 20px;}
6. `#logo` {  
    margin-top:15px;}  
    html: class="span-4"
7. `h1` {  
    font-family:Verdana, Geneva, sans-serif;  
    font-size:24px;  
    font-weight:normal;  
    color:#eee;  
    margin-bottom:10px;}
8. `p` {  
    font-family:Verdana, Geneva, sans-serif;  
    font-size:11px;  
    color:#fff;  
    margin:0px;  
    line-height:16px;}
9. `#header` {  
    padding-top:35px;}  
    html: class="span-14"
10. `#nav_primary` {  
    margin-top:25px;  
    color:#9c0;  
    text-align:right;  
    font-size:9px;}  
    html: class="span-14 append-6 right last"

11. `h2` {  
    font-family:Verdana, Geneva, sans-serif;  
    font-size:12px;  
    font-weight:bold;  
    color:#9c0;  
    margin-bottom:10px;}
12. `#content p` {margin:0px 0px 10px 0px;}
13. `ul` {  
    font-family: Verdana, Geneva, sans-serif;  
    font-size: 11px;  
    color: #fff;  
    margin: 0px 0px 10px -15px;}
14. `li` {  
    list-style-type:none;}
15. `#content` {  
    margin-top:30px;}  
    html: class="span-14"
16. Modify>Page Properties>Links:  
    font-family: Verdana, Geneva, sans-serif;  
    font-size: 9px;  
    Links & Visited: #bbb, Hover & Active: #fff  
    Underline: **only on rollover**
17. Organize and clean up all CSS rules using the CSS Styles palette.
18. Cut/Paste CSS rules to a new blank stylesheet: "ptalpha\_master.css". Save into your existing CSS folder. Attach your new css file to your index.html by using a <link> tag in the head of your html.
19. Remove <style> tags from your html and be sure the paths to your images in the CSS point to the image files correctly, for example:  
    url(../images/bgblue.jpg)  
    url(../images/bggreen.jpg)
20. Save as prototype\_text.html.

21. Use this same process for each kind of layout, creating a prototype and repeating for each major section of your site. For example:  
    prototype\_text.html  
    prototype\_galleries.html  
    prototype\_2columns.html  
    etc. These prototypes will be the basis for your upcoming Template files.
