Web Design: Week 7 Assignments

- 1. Do the reading for Week 7. See syllabus. (due next week)
- 2. Use the info from your Domain Name Registrar & Web Host to fill out your Hosting/Domain Worksheet.
- 3. Work on your website by taking your finished (or mostly finished) prototype files from week 6 and creating template files from them. Then create any necessary child pages from those templates.

Guidelines

Follow the procedure demonstrated in class and outlined below to setup work on your website this week with the Templates.

- 1. Open your prototype file and "Save as Template". Name it something like "template_text.dwt". Note that the .dwt extension will automatically be applied and the file will be saved into a Templates folder.
- 2. Select any content that will be editable from page to page, then go to Insert>Template Objects>Editable Region. Name the new region something like "content_area".
- 3. Verify in your file that the template code is in the right place. Save and close the template.
- 4. Create any needed child pages from your template by going to: File>New. In the next window select Page from Template>your website, and then the correct template file.
- 5. Now edit the content in your editable region if needed, and save your new child page. Child pages are the final publishable files for your site so file names might look something like this: index.html about.html contact.html, etc.
- 6. To edit content within an editable region, open the specific child page that holds that content. To edit content outside of editable regions, open the parent template of those child pages.
